Across the city, community-centered design continues to thrive, yet a huge disparity persists in new investments and neighborhood resources. 


# One Book One Northwestern Books Available for Purchase


OLLI is excited to be participating in One Book One Northwestern again this year. There will be events on campus for the whole Northwestern community as well as special events at OLLI for our members.
