Do you have an idea for a study group, but are not sure what





What happened when a relatively sheltered 16-year-old experienced up close the Democratic Convention of 1968. Join us as Rick Kogan shares his first-hand experience of the "four insane days" that made up the convention and ponders, fifty years later, what it all meant in U.S. History.

Rick Kogan was born, raised, and still lives in Chicago. He has worked for the Chicago Daily News, Chicago Sun-Times and the Chicago Tribune, where he is currently a senior writer and columnist. Named Chicago's Best Reporter in 1999 and inducted into the Chicago Journalism Hall of Fame in 2003, he is currently a host of After Hours with Rick Kogan on WGN-AM720. He is the author of a dozen books, including America's Mom: The Life, Lessons and Legacy of Ann Landers, and A Chicago Tavern, the history of the Billy Goat.



Chicago - Major Construction on Lake Shore Drive

Major construction continues on Lake Shore Drive. **If you are driving or taking the shuttle your travel time will be impacted. Expect delays and plan your travel accordingly.** The construction spans from LaSalle to Monroe, but the back up is significant. The project is on an accelerated schedule that will require lane closures reducing Lake Shore Drive to two lanes in each direction.
