Join us for this fun, social outing.

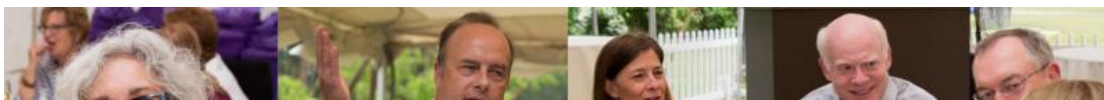

The Two Koreas Study Group Evanston, Spring 2018

The Two Koreas study group, which convened at Evanston OLLI during the spring semester, informed and educated 16 participants about the history and challenges of the Korean people from the beginning of recorded history to the present. The study group engaged in readings, viewing of documentary footage and discussion of current events on and around the Korean peninsula. Participants were also given the opportunity to hear from additional experts on Korea including the Honorable Jong-Kook Lee, Consul General of the Republic of Korea. At the conclusion of the study group, all agreed that the background information we acquired was invaluable in helping us better



we acquired was invaluable in helping us better appreciate and understand the very important issues of war and peace involving North and South Korea today.

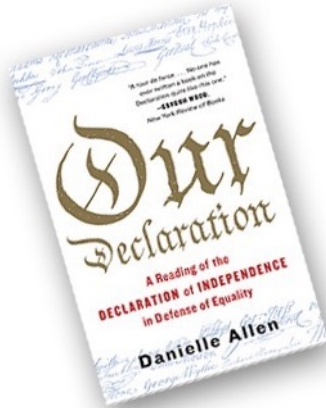
